Privacy Statement: To enable the Union to effectively look after your interests, the Union may provide some of your personal details to third parties such as superannuation, redundancy trusts, income protection providers and others. Financial Obligations: Members are liable to pay enrolment fees (Rule 9 CEPU), entrance fees (R13 PGEU), contributions (R10 Communication, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia / R14 PGEU), levies (R11 CEPU / R 15 PGEU) and fines (R 12 CEPU / R 84 PGEU) provided that a member of the PGEU who is a financial member of the CEPU and assigned to the Plumbing Division Queensland Branch, shall not be required to pay contributions to the PGEU. A member resigning shall be liable for the payment of all contributions, levies and fines respectively owing to the CEPU and/or the PGEU under their respective rules as at the date of leaving, and such monies may be sued for and recovered in the name of the CEPU and/or PGEU pursuant to the Workplace Relations Act or the Industrial Relations Act, as the case may be.

Resignation: A member of the CEPU may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the Branch Secretary, with the resignation taking effect where the member ceases to be eligible for membership of the Union, on the day on which the notice is received by the Division, or on the day specified in the notice, which is a day not earlier than the day on which the member ceases to be eligible to be a member, whichever is the later, or in any other case at the end of two weeks or on the day specified in the notice, whichever is the later. A member of the PGEU may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the PGEU, with the resignation taking effect on the day or time specified in the notice or, if no day or time is specified, when the notice is given.
